An information evening for parents and Year 6 students will be held at Avalon Intermediate School on Thursday 20 August between 6pm - 7:30pm.

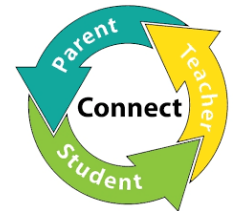
HEAD LICE

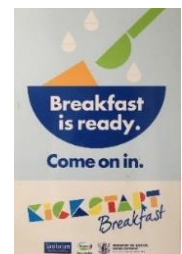
SICK CHILDREN

SPORTS FEES



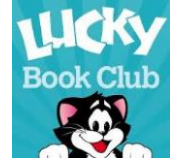

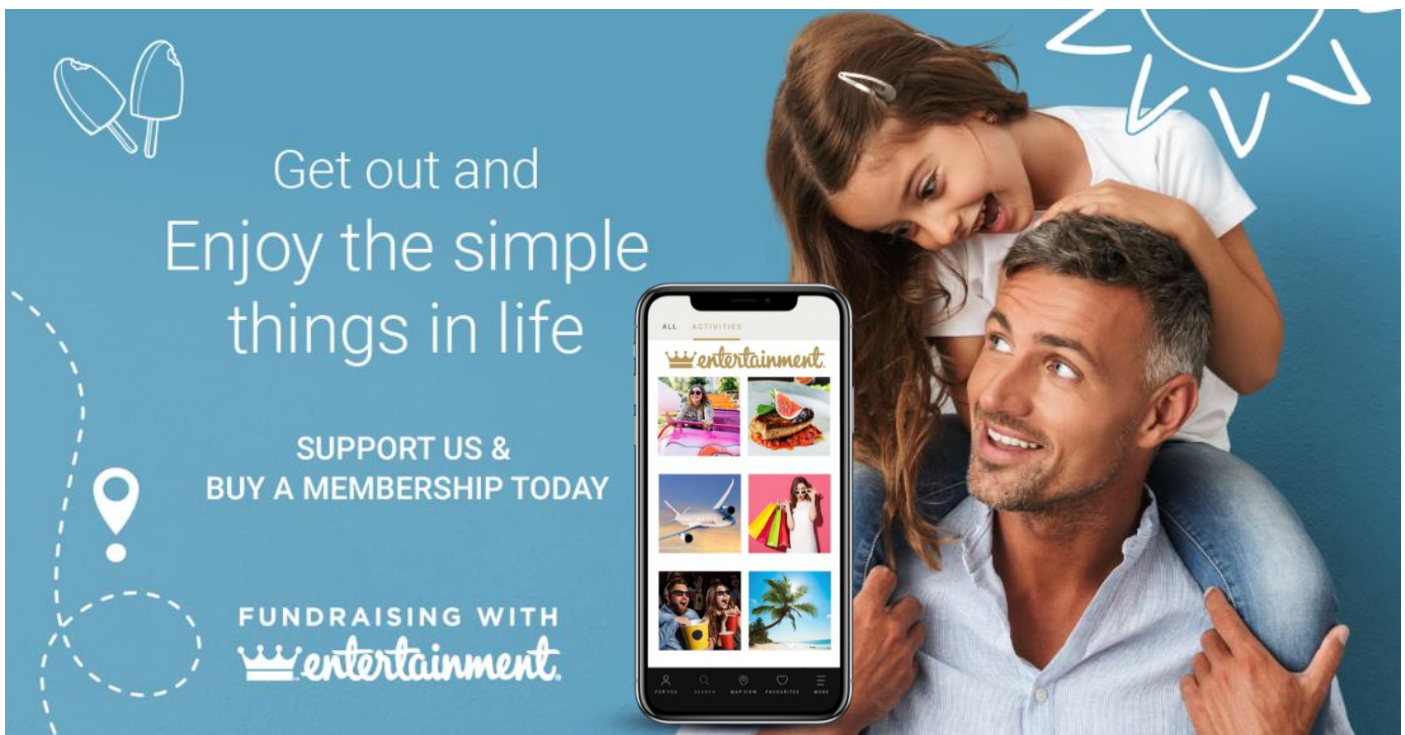
