# **CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19 ALERT LEVEL 1 GUIDELINES**

We are continuing with drop off/pick up processes that we have in place as well as working to maintain hand hygiene with regular washing and sanitizing.

We ask that sick children stay at home – even if they are feeling slightly unwell children need to remain at home and parents contact school. We ask that parents take their children to see the doctor if they are showing any symptoms linked to COVID-19 such as a fever, cough, sore throat, loss of taste or smell.

If children display any signs of illness at school, we will put a face mask on them, put them in the medical room and contact parents/caregivers to come and pick them up.
