He Kura Asthma Study

This year our school is taking part in the He Study with the University of Otago and Tu Maori Asthma Trust. The study aims to



guidelines and resources to help us to improve support for our students with asthma. Asthma is a big problem in New Zealand with one in five children having asthma symptoms. The ways in which schools support a child with asthma can have a significant impact on their asthma control and learning. Our staff have received asthma training from Asthma Wellington and our school now has asthma emergency kits. Other parts of the study include student asthma education, an environmental assessment and linkages with healthcare providers. There will be regular information about asthma in our newsletters and on our Website this year.
