**HUTT CITY LIBRARIES DIGITAL WELL-BEING WORKSHOPS – (FREE)**

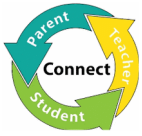

We are looking for some good keen people to help as tutor readers on a Wednesday and Thursday. If you are able to spare about an hour and help do some reading with our children, please contact the office.

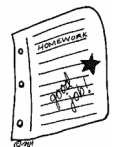


## SUPPORTING YOUR CHILDREN WITH THEIR LEARNING

## STUDY CENTRE

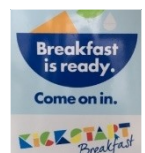
There will be no study centre this week due to 3-way conferences and illness.
