HUTT CITY COUNCIL RACE TO 90%

We are proud to be participating in a *Race to 90%* vaccination drive between Porirua and Lower Hutt. The aim of this drive is to get 90% of Porirua and Lower Hutt double-vaccinated

against COVID-19 to protect our friends, family and community from the Delta variant.

Both cities aren't too far off reaching the 90% mark, but there is more to do. As part of the *Race to 90%* drive, the Hutt Mana Charitable Trust and Hutt City Council have teamed up and will donate \$3,000 to our school - but only if our city reaches 90%.

Currently Hutt City is at 90% first vaccination and 81% second vaccination

We need to do everything we can to increase vaccination uptake in Stokes Valley. That way we can protect our community and the wider city from COVID-19, and inch our way closer to getting \$3,000 for our school. Once we get there, we plan to use the \$3,000 in a way that will benefit their health and well-being. We will ask the children for ideas.
