Have a look at these wonderful KORAU kids that have been displaying their KORAU values throughout their time at Kura. Ka rawe koutou!



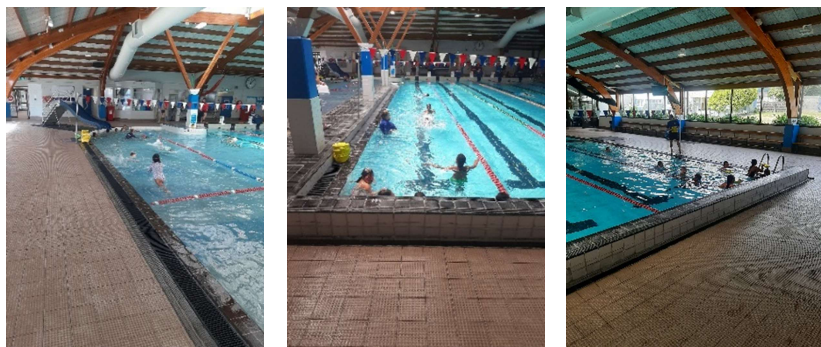
## **CHINESE NEW YEAR**
