## MATHS AND LITERACY "HAVE A GO" EVENING


Come and join us for a fun and informative session where we will be sharing about how structured literacy and maths are taught in our classrooms.

### SCHOOL INVOICES

### ROAD SAFETY AROUND THE SCHOOL – DRIVE SAFELY

We have noticed a number of dangerous driving behaviours such as

- Driving up onto the berm to do a U-turn or drop
- people doing U-turns on the road around the road patrols,
- using driveways to park in to collect children
- driving fast around the road patrols and school

These are all <u>dangerous behaviours that are putting children and pedestrians at risk</u>. Please drive responsibly around the school and if needed, park up the road or on Montgomery Street and walk up to school to collect your children.



We ask that parents please remind their children that they are not to bring their toys to school. Toys coming to school can cause unneeded disruption both in class and in the playground. The only time it will be okay for toys to come to school will be if your child's teacher informs you this is okay.



### 2PM CLUB

All children will need to be booked into 2PM Club by clicking here Every Wednesday and Friday we run 2pm Club between 2.00-3.00pm for children whose parents book them in for this service. The cost of 2pm Club is \$2.00/session. This is to cover the cost of supervision during these times. If your child is not coming to 2pm you need to contact the office for that specific day. If your child is on the casual list and are attending you also need to let the office know for that day.



### BANK ACCOUNTS
